Teen Driver Challenge

Are you a permitted or licensed "Teen Driver," ages 15–19, who would like to learn more about safe driving and live in Lee County? Do you have access to a safe and insured vehicle you can use while taking this class? If so, you meet the requirements to take the **Teen Driver Challenge**, a two-day "hands-on" education program held at the Lee County Sheriff's Office and Buckingham Airfield. Participate in this class and you will be more prepared to drive safe. **SEATING IS LIMITED!!!**

The Teen Driver Challenge course will provide you with the knowledge and hands-on experience to reduce your chances of being involved in a crash. Your attendance and participation in this training will provide you with life saving skills, techniques and education about the operation of a motor vehicle. The driving skills you will learn are the same techniques used by driving professionals, including NASCAR.

DAY 1: Classroom Training

Students will participate in a four-hour session that will cover the following topics:

- Teen Crash Facts
- Knowing Your Vehicle
- Using your Senses
- Vehicle Dynamics
- Safe Driving Habits
- Alcohol and Driving
- Aggressive Driving
- Driving Exercises

DAY 2: Vehicle Operations

Students will participate in an eight-hour driving class that will cover the following exercises:

- Threshold/Emergency Braking
- Backing
- Cornering
- Forward serpentine
- Reverse serpentine
- Off road recovery
- Evasive maneuvers
