This position involves protecting the public and preserving the peace, and serving in any of a variety of assignments in the Sheriff's Office. As a Deputy Sheriff, you need to interpret and enforce all applicable federal, state and local laws, general orders, directives, and policies and procedures of the Sheriff's Office. The Deputy Sheriff must be able to work independently under limited supervision. Deputies work a rotating shift that will include weekends and holidays. Applicants must have successfully passed the State Officer Certification Examination (SOCE).

REQUIREMENTS:

- ★ Must be a legal citizen of the United States.
- ★ Must be 21 years or older.
- ★ Must have a High School Diploma or equivalent.
- ★ Possess a valid Florida Driver's License.
- ★ Possess a Social Security Card.
- ★ If previously a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, service and discharge must be honorable or under honorable conditions.
- ★ Be of good moral character, having no felony convictions; no misdemeanor convictions involving moral character, perjury, or false statement, as outlined in the Florida State Statute.
