JOB DESCRIPTION:

School Resource Officers shall be subject to the duties and responsibilities outlined for all sworn personnel. The School Resource Officer is primarily responsible for working within the school system to build positive relationships between students, faculty and the Sheriff's Office while enforcing the laws and promoting a safe gang and drug free environment. Primary emphasis will be to work with the students from Kindergarten thru 12th grade. Motivation to work with youth along with the ability to gain respect of adolescents and teenagers while holding them accountable for their actions are required traits of the deputies assigned to the position. The School Resource Officer will serve as a resource throughout the school system and will be required to perform the functions of Law Enforcement Deputy, educator and counselor while becoming an integral member of the school community.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ★ Must be a Certified Law Enforcement Deputy. If certified out of state you may be considered for an equivalency of training sponsorship.
- ★ Must have at least one year of Law Enforcement Road Patrol experience.
- ★ Must possess above average written and verbal communication skills and have the ability to instruct children or young adults in a classroom setting.

- ★ Familiarity and understanding of the juvenile justice system; investigate and interview techniques desired.
- ★ The ability to learn and apply through work knowledge of the juvenile laws of the State of Florida and successfully complete the S.R.O. training course.
- ★ Must take and pass the Physical Abilities Testing (PAT) with a time of 6:04.
