

#### **MICROCHIPPING LEE COUNTY'S PETS**

According to an American Kennel Club article, one in three pets will become lost or wander away from home during the course of their lives. Many never return.

The Lee County Sheriff's Office and Lee County

Domestic Animal Services are working diligently to
ensure that our county's dogs and cats are
microchipped, greatly improving the chances that lost
pets are reunited with their owner(s).

Monthly, both agencies have joined forces, using LCSO community outreach centers, to both check pets for the existence of a microchip and, if none



exist, insert a microchip at no cost.

The chip is usually injected beneath your pet's loose skin and shoulder

blade, has no moving parts and requires no battery or power source. The life expectancy of each chip is approximately 20 years.

May's microchipping event will be held at the Lee County Sheriff's Office Community Outreach Center at the Coconut Point Mall, Suite 101 from 11am-1pm. **MAY 2025**

"Hands Only CPR" is a simplified method that uses chest compressions only.

In addition to the CPR instruction, Captain Roy addressed choking issues involving adults and children.


